Highlights of Accomplishments

PCRD had a very good 2022! Aside from all the impacts already shared on this report, we wanted to highlight a couple that we are very proud of. First, PCRD is spearheading the development of Indiana's first-ever five-year digital equity plan along with the Indiana State Budget Agency and the Indiana Broadband Office. The process is data-driven and has gathered and analyzed data from the U.S. Census Bureau, key informant interviews, and a statewide survey. In addition, a statewide digital equity task force was formed. This task force is guiding the efforts, ensuring multiple groups and their perspectives are kept in mind, and writing the plan. Once draft strategies and barriers are identified, six regional solutions sessions will be conducted this summer to further fine-tune the barriers and strategies as well as compile objectives or solutions. We are hoping to unveil the plan in the fall of this year.

The second project we are very proud of is one working with the Economic Development Administration (EDA) and a team comprised of Brookings, RTI, and others to evaluate, research, and establish a community of practice around EDA's Build Back Better Regional Challenge (BBBRC) program. The BBBRC program is investing \$1 billion on 21 coalitions across the nation resulting in inclusive growth and economic competitiveness. PCRD will be gathering data through surveys, proprietary datasets, and ripple effect mapping sessions on 21 coalitions and their activities to document and understand the impact of the program. In the end, PCRD will help inform economic development policy through tools and resources, dashboards, and best practices.

As you can see we were very busy during 2022 and look forward to what 2023 and beyond will bring. This of course would not be possible without our awesome team, stakeholders, and partners. Thank you for your support!


