Who are these programs for?

- Existing Small Meat Packers
- Those that want to start or expand a meat processing business
- Individuals who would like to train to become meat cutters

Overview of Services Provided

- **Funding options** for those interested in starting or expanding an Indiana meat packing / processing business.
 - Applies to all Indiana meat and poultry packers and processors that are not members of "the big four" (Cargill, Tyson Foods, JBS SA and National Beef Packing)
- No-cost **professional business counseling** for agribusiness via the Indiana SBDC Agribusiness Initiative
 - Applies to all meat packing businesses that meet the "small" classification as defined by the SBA (less than 1,000 employees), including those interested in starting a new business
- **Training scholarships** that are available for employees of small and start-up meat packers /processors to the Boiler Butcher Basics Workshops (talleres disponible en español)
 - Restricted to meat packers with less than 50 employees and less than \$1 million in sales
 - Initial priority is for businesses located in the five REDM regions* (see citation below)
 - Spanish language instruction will be provided, as needed
- Training scholarships to Boiler Butcher Basics Workshops for those individuals who wish to become meat cutters and / or interested in starting a business that requires meat cutting
- Becas de capacitación a Boiler Butcher Basics Talleres para aquellas personas que deseen convertirse en cortadores de carne y/o estén interesadas en iniciar un negocio que requiera corte de carne
 - Initial priority to residents of the five REDM regions*(see below)
 - Featuring Spanish language instruction, as needed
- One small meat processing / packing business will qualify for a pilot session of Reality Spanish / Reality English for agribusiness*
