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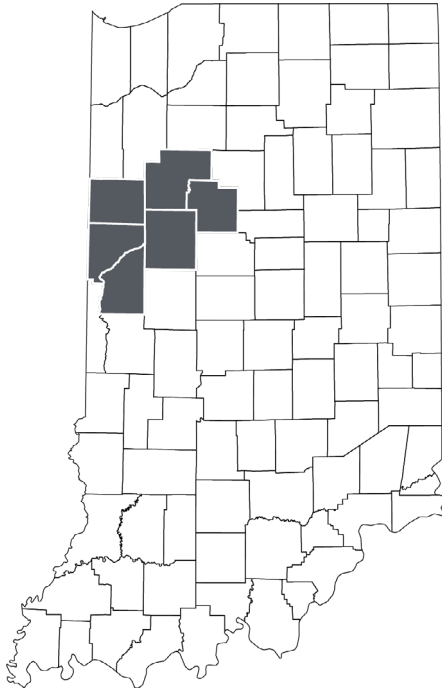

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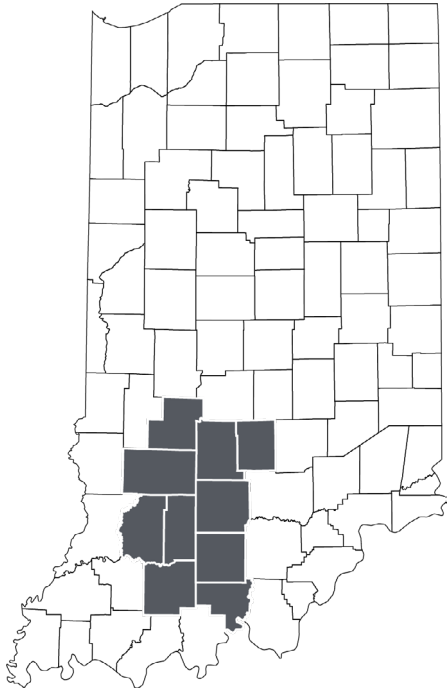


## READI 1.0 - REGION MIGRATION ANALYSIS INDIANA UPLANDS
